



Partnership

In the first of what we hope will be a series of partnerships with the University of Stirling, our exhibitions for the year were curated by post graduate students from the MSc Environment, Heritage and History course.

Miriam Erikson curated the Bannockburn exhibition marking the 700th anniversary of the battle and Joana Krogsrud worked on the Golf and other Scottish Sports

displays, to coincide with the 2014 Ryder Cup, played at Gleneagles. As well as selecting books and setting up the displays, the students produced a catalogue of commentary to accompany the exhibitions.

Later in the year Innerpeffray's Keeper of Books gave a presentation to the next year of students on the course which looked at Innerpeffray's history and the day to day of running a small museum.

Events

We have hosted several private functions and conferences during the year, as well as our own events, in particular a talk on **The Charge of the Light Brigade** from Dr Roger Cartwright and a talk on **The Stuarts** by Dr Clare Jackson, and the

Connected Collections Conference: Universities of Glasgow, Dundee, and Stirling on the role of archives.

Volunteers

We now have ten volunteers: without this team of helpers we would not be able to sustain the quality and quantity of work that the Library offers.
