



Restoring A Historic Landscape

The woodland area south of the School, Chapel and Library leading down to the river will be replanted to establish a woodland which reflects the historic setting of Innerpeffray Library and to celebrate native trees of Scotland. We want to tell the story of why this tiny part of Scotland is so important; from the Ice Age to the present day. It will reflect what trees the Romans brought, the heritage of tree introductions by famous Scots explorers and trees important to the making and printing of books. We hope the woodland will act as an educational asset to the existing book collection in the Library. Seats on the new walk will offer a place to relax, rest and contemplate and are specially designed to blend with the landscape and the library setting.

There are several exciting ways you can be involved:

£25 - Will get you a small tree planted and a bio-degradable ribbon with your name tied to it. Start to create your own family tree by sponsoring several trees for family members. If you sponsor more than 2 trees, you will be listed on a framed panel in the foyer of the School Room. This panel will be hand scribed as a celebration of the project and all those who assisted in the development and completion. Anyone donating more than £50 will be listed.

£100 - Will sponsor the purchase, planting and care of a larger specimen or tree of significance to the library. Your name will be engraved onto a plaque by your sponsored tree and your name added to our special panel in the School room. We will also send out a card with the details of your tree and its significance to the Library.

£500—Will sponsor the new seating areas amongst the trees. We are creating beautiful dry stone wall features, seats will be incorporated into these features where you can sit and watch the world go by and the trees grow. Your name will be on a stone forming the wall surrounding the benches.
